Dear Jamie Evans

Thank you for your confirmation of the range of economic benefits that will result from the extension to the quarry that you have given in your consultation response to the DNPA about E&JW Glendinning's planning application for an extension to Linhay Hill Quarry, copy attached.

This is to respond on behalf of Glendinning to the points that you raised in paras 5 and 9.

In para 5 you ask how the average income of employees at Ashburton compares with the Teignbridge average of £23,138 (2015).

The answer is that using year-end 2016 data the average pay of the 153 employees based in Ashburton (i.e. quarry and Glentor office) is **£30,314**.

This figure excludes employer pension contribution, life assurance and health benefits, car and van benefits and is **31% above the 2015 Teignbridge average**.

In para 9 you mention the possibility of exploring the feasibility of improving broadband connectivity in the local area. Interestingly this has already been raised by the residents at Waye, who see the relaying of the telecommunications duct along the Waye Lane route as an opportunity to improve their internet speeds, and Glendinning has already agreed to this direct with them.

I hope this is helpful.
